## noah antwiler

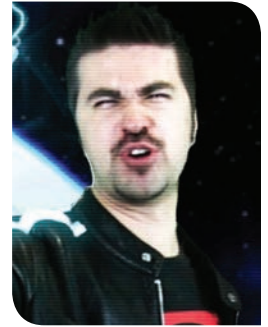

Mike works with “Handsome” Tom Hanley’s thegameheroes.com where Mike co-hosts the Prototype podcast. He is also a contributor for Blistered Thumbs and Channel Awesome as well as appearing as a video game expert for several radio chains in Canada and the United States.

Most recently Mike is known as the creator and main contributor of **reviewaday.ca** where he has made it his personal mission to review video games on an almost daily basis for his fans. Mike continues doing what he loves every day, making him a pioneer in taking Canadian new-media journalism into the 21st century and beyond!



## the 404s

The 404s are North America’s oldest and best known Anime Improv team, with performers based in the Canadian cities of Calgary, Edmonton and Toronto. Mai Sheri has been active in the Toronto cosplay community since 2004, when she discovered that her love for making elaborate Hallowe'en costumes could eventually evolve into a full-time hobby.

## featherweight

Nicknamed the “God of Cardboard” and the “MacGyver of Cosplay”, his transformation of bargain-bin materials into high quality products has earned Featherweight a reputation as a prop design master.

## dawn mckechnie

Also known as “Kaijugal”, Dawn has been involved in the Canadian costuming community for 20+ years. An artist and self described “costuming enthusiast” she has won numerous awards for her unique creations over the years, including several Best In Shows.

## maral agnerian

Known in cosplay circles as Sarcasm-hime, she’s been costuming since 1999. When she realized there were places where you could dress up *all weekend*, she was hooked. Her work has won her numerous awards and these days she’s often found judging or doing backstage work.

## ricky dick

Ricky Dick – sometimes known as Gravely MacCabre from his american horror host TV show and award winning Haunted Attraction, Castle Blood, has been attending conventions since 1979 and won his first “Best in Show” in 1981. Yup, 30 years ago.

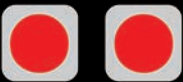
