



## ***ARTIST'S ALLEY REGULATIONS***

As a resident of Artist's Alley, you will be expected to follow certain guidelines during your stay. Any questions or concerns you may have regarding these regulations may be sent to [artists@conbravo.com](mailto:artists@conbravo.com). A response will be issued at the first possible opportunity. **Please note that the crew of ConBravo! reserves the right to evict any resident of the alley for breaking these regulations.**

- I. An artist may only use the space assigned to them regardless of vacancy at other or adjacent tables. If an artist's materials encroach on the space of another artist, they will be asked to move said materials back within the confines of their assigned space.
- II. Any materials which are pornographic, sexually explicit, depict excessive gore, or feature excessive profanity must be labelled with a warning and may need to be temporarily censored when displayed.
- III. Selling pornographic materials to minors is strictly prohibited.
- IV. If you are being harassed by a patron, fellow artist, or other attendee, please report it to the crew immediately. Do not engage in counter harassment.
- V. You may not block the view of another artist's wares with your own displays. If the alley crew feels a display is obstructive and may hurt the sales of another artist, you may be asked to remove the offending item.
- VI. Leaving your table is allowed for a 30-minute timespan. If you wish to have a friend mind your table, please speak with an alley representative to be issued a "helper" ticket. Said tickets will be good for a limited amount of time. Please note that you are solely responsible for the security of your wares.
- VII. The display and selling of copyrighted material will be left to the discretion of the artist. ConBravo! is in no way responsible for the content of displayed or provided works.
- VIII. Limited power is provided in the room. If you require power, you may either request to be near a plug, or bring your own supply. Note that external supplies must be cleared with the alley crew.
- IX. Retractable knives and other sharp implements must not be left unattended in plain view on a table.
- X. The use of open flame in the alley is strictly prohibited.
- XI. No refunds to the alley will be issued past **May 31st 2010**.
- XII. Any damage to the alley caused by a resident will be the resident's responsibility to pay for and/or replace.
